

## FIFTIETH YEAR REUNION OF 1966 BATCH



The 1966 batch of College of Engineering, Guindy celebrated the fiftieth year of entering the portals of the College by honouring their teachers and organizing a reunion.

The teachers were honoured at the meeting at 6.00 pm on Saturday, February 5. There were more than one hundred persons at the Alumni Centre comprising of Guindineers 66, their spouses and wards. There were interesting recollections of the 1966 batch students on their student days and response from the faculty.

The next day they assembled at one of the Guest Houses at East Coast Road and spent an enjoyable and nostalgic day there.

The unique feature of the Reunion was that they facilitated the replacement of the ten existing metal halide lamps with imported LED lamps at Anna University entrance road. The LED lamps with aluminum die cast fittings will consume less than fifty percent of electricity and will also double the illumination output.
