Alumni Centre, CEG

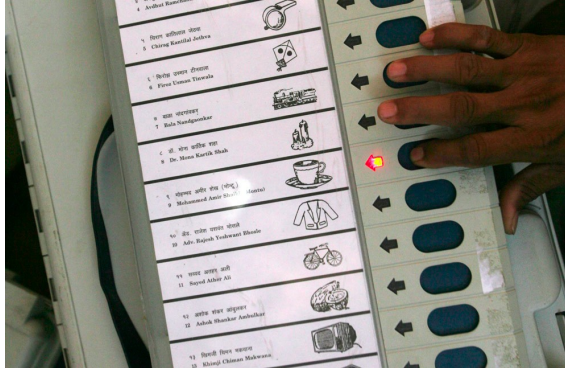

TWELVE MORE ENGINEERING COLLEGES FOR TAMIL NADU



All India Council of Technical Education (AICTE) has given approval to twelve new engineering institutions in Tamil Nadu. Ninety four new technical institutions have applied for approval of which sixty three had cleared the scrutiny of Anna University. AICTE has cleared twelve of these engineering institutions. A three member appellate authority is examining the compliance reports of the remaining fifty institutions

This is in addition to 454 existing engineering colleges.

Anna University has issued notices 67 engineering colleges affiliated to it citing deficiencies. They were requested to remedy them to enable affiliation to continue. A decision on the reports submitted by the institutions would be taken at the earliest.

Hence the number of seats available under the process of single window counseling for engineering admissions is not yet clear.

COUNSELLING FOR ENGINEERING SEATS

The counseling for engineering admissions will start on June 28. The schedule is as follows:

Sports Quota -	June 28
Vocational Candidates -	June 29 to July 3
Differently Abled Persons -	July 4.
General counseling for Academic Candidates -	from July 5.

About 1,10,000 seats are estimated to be available. However there may be an increase due to inclusion of new colleges and reduction in seats due to disaffiliation.
